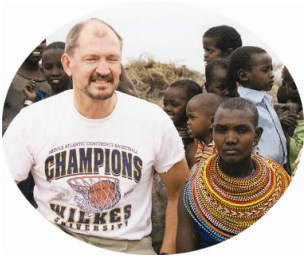


Dr. J's Excellent Adventure Down Under



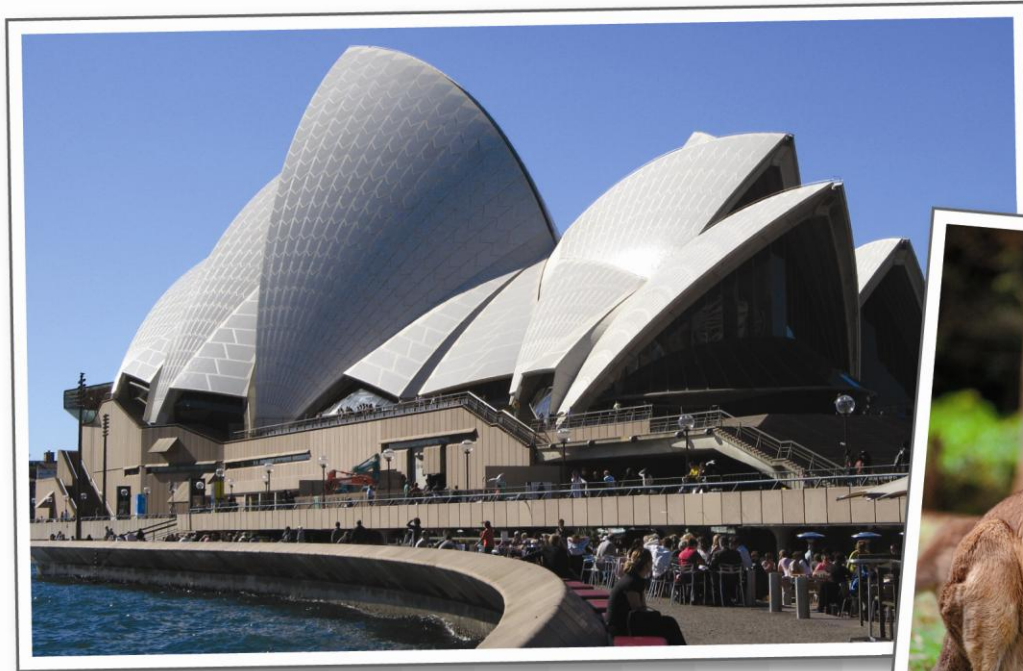

Day 4: Sunday, July 04, 2010

Melbourne

Today's tour of Melbourne features Fitzroy Gardens, valued for their historic, architectural, and horticultural significance. Later, you may like to participate in an optional tour that travels to Phillip Island, arriving at the fascinating home of the world's largest colony of Little Penguins. See hundreds of these lovable birds waddling out from the sea as they cross the beach to their burrows in the dunes during the Little Penguin Parade. On this option you will also visit the interpretation center where you will learn about the life of the Little Penguins and their significance to the area. Dinner is included on Phillip Island when you purchase this option. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 5: Monday, July 05, 2010

Melbourne - Alice Springs

You fly to Alice Springs, located in the heart of Central Australia and the Outback. A sightseeing tour includes the Old Telegraph Station and Anzac Hill, with its excellent view of Alice Springs and the surrounding area. Gain insight into the educational system in the Outback with a visit to the School of the Air - you may even see a class in session! A special experience is in store for you this afternoon as you will have the opportunity to meet the young Aboriginal group, Drum Atweme. Day 6: Tuesday, July 06, 2010

Alice Springs

Discover the culture of the Aboriginal people this morning during the 'Dreamtime Tour'. Your specialist guide, along with members of the Walpiri tribe, will tell you their stories of creation and show you the every day activities of the Aboriginals. You will meet these people at their camp and watch as various dreamtime stories are depicted in paintings. Tonight you may choose to "Take a Camel to Dinner" (optional) during which you'll enjoy a camel ride through the Outback to your dinner. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 7: Wednesday, July 07, 2010

Alice Springs - Ayers Rock

Today you drive to Ayers Rock in the heart of the Australian Outback. This huge

monolith and the sandstone domes of the Olgas were created through the process of upheaval and erosion. **★As the sun sets, enjoy a champagne toast and watch as Ayers Rock magically changes color.★** *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 8: Thursday, July 08, 2010

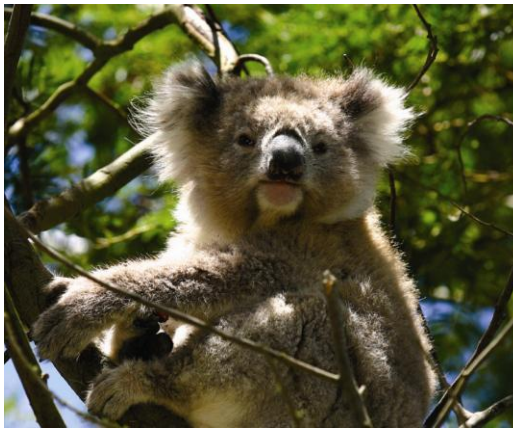
Ayers Rock - Cairns

Today, tour the Olgas and the base of "the Rock," learning about their significance to the Aboriginal culture before leaving behind Australia's Outback. This afternoon you are off to Cairns, the gateway to the Great Barrier Reef. One of the world's most spectacular natural attractions, the reef was established as a marine park in 1975 and is a collective haven for thousands of species of sea life, as well as turtles and birds. In 1981 the United Nations designated the Great Barrier Reef a World Heritage site.

Day 9: Friday, July 09, 2010

Great Barrier Reef

Board a high-speed catamaran for an exciting excursion on the Great Barrier Reef. From your base on Green Island, you are able to explore the reef in many ways. Enjoy a trip on a glass bottom boat* where beautifully colored fish swim beneath in their natural habitat. Choose a stroll on the walking trail to take in the rain forest and the beaches, or watch the fish and sea turtles swim past from the pier. You may also visit the underwater observatory. For a more adventurous encounter with the reef, optional scuba diving, snorkeling and an outer reef tour are also available. *Today breakfast and lunch will be included.*



Day 10: Saturday, July 10, 2010

Cairns - Sydney

Explore the rain forest canopy this morning on an optional skyrail tour; make a few stops on the ascent to experience the beauty of this World Heritage Site. Depart for the exciting city of Sydney this afternoon. The evening is yours to independently explore one of the world's friendliest cities. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 11: Sunday, July 11, 2010

Sydney

Today is a full day exploring the fun-loving city of Sydney. Begin with a tour that includes sights such as Kings Cross, the Harbour Bridge, Chinatown, the Rocks, Circular Quay, the Botanic Gardens and the fashionable suburb of Paddington. Visit the koala sanctuary and see Australia's most famous animal species in its natural habitat...you even have the opportunity to pet one! This evening's experience is unforgettable as you dine while cruising the harbour, enjoying views of the city's great icons - the Harbour Bridge and the Sydney Opera House. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 12: Monday, July 12, 2010

Sydney

For all passengers visiting Fiji, there is an additional \$40 USD per person in taxes and fees to be paid with final payment.

Taxes/fees to be paid in local currencies upon exiting New Zealand are approximately 25 NZD (approx. \$15 USD).

To complete your vacation, we include roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing Collette airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

The Fiji portion of this tour will be hosted by a local representative.

*If you purchase the outer reef option in the Great Barrier Reef, the glass bottom boat ride will be replaced by a semi-submersible boat on the outer reef pontoon.

Due to changes in air schedules while on tour, the order of days in the itinerary may change.

IMPORTANT RESERVATION INFORMATION

Visa Requirements:

US and Canadian citizens - ETA (Electronic Travel Authority). Travel agents may do ETAs through their own CRS systems at no charge to the passenger (SABRE - F*TTL/ETAS; WORLDSPAN - HELP ETAS; APOLLO - HELP ETAS). If the travel agent chooses not to process these through their CRS system, they call Qantas at 800-227-4632 no earlier than 30 days prior to departure, between 10 AM - 12 PM Pacific Time, Monday through Friday. They must have a credit card number available. Note: direct clients and group leaders are supplied with ETA form and asked to fax info back to Collette (in care of the Australian ETA Coordinator at fax 401-727-2933 for US passengers and for Canadian passengers fax to 905-624-2420) 45 days prior to departure. The information that is required included: booking number, passport number, expiration date, nationality, country of birth, sex, family name given, first name given, middle name given, and arrival date.

Passports and Visas are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require a minimum of 6 months passport validity from date of return home. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.
