### Important

- Tuition rate for 2009-10 is \$370 per credit or \$1,110 per 3 credit course plus any applicable use fee.
- Online registration is recommended. If you need a registration form, please visit [www.wilkes.edu/GradEd](http://www.wilkes.edu/GradEd) & select Grad Ed Forms link from the left to print a form.

Every student is issued a Wilkes ID# (WIN) to use as his/her student number. Memorize your WIN & use it for all communications with Wilkes. It begins with 900 and is displayed on all grade reports, invoices and transcripts. If you cannot locate your WIN, you must contact the Wilkes University Help Desk @ 1-866-264-1462. Graduate Education cannot give out that information. New graduate students are sent a Wilkes WIN and email account after their application is processed.

### MyWilkes Portal

Current graduate students have 24/7 online access to their records and accounts from the Wilkes portal. You may access the MyWilkes portal from the Wilkes home page at [www.wilkes.edu](http://www.wilkes.edu) under Quick links or go to [mywilkes.wilkes.edu](http://mywilkes.wilkes.edu) and use your email user name (firstname.lastname) and password to log in. The default password is upper case initial of your last name, lower case initial of your first name, last 6 digits of your WIN. ex: Joe Doe, WIN(900123456), password = Dj123456 **NOTE: If you have previously changed your password, you must use your changed password. Click on the 'Student Services' tab to access the registration links and other important services. If you have any problems, please call the Help Desk @ 1-866-264-1462.**

### Registration

**Registration will open early morning at 12:01 am on Monday, March 22nd. Many courses fill quickly, so register early! Online registration is preferred and available through the MyWilkes portal. If you register online, please do not mail the registration form. Tuition deferment is automatic with online registration.** Registrations are on a first-come, first-served basis. **Be sure to register for the correct CRN#, course & section from this schedule.** Wilkes will not be responsible for an incorrect course enrollment. **Do NOT try to register online from school computers guarded by firewalls. You may have difficulty. Try from a home computer. Telephone registrations are not accepted. Permission only registrations must be mailed or faxed. If we are unable to register you, we will contact you.**

**\*Note: If it has been longer than 1 year since your last course, you will NOT be able to register online without first being readmitted in our system.** Go to [www.wilkes.edu/GradEd](http://www.wilkes.edu/GradEd), click on the readmit form link, answer the questions, and hit submit to be readmitted. **Do not submit a new application.** It will take approximately 24-48 hours for the readmit to be processed and for online registration to be available to you. You must know your email user name & password to register online. You could mail your registration form, if that would be quicker.

Courses with less than 7 enrolled 1 week prior to the scheduled start may be cancelled, so register early if you intend to take a class. Registration for online courses closes 1 week before the start date to allow the necessary set-up time for student access to the course.

### Graduating Students \*\*\* IMPORTANT NOTE\*\*\*

If completing your last course this semester, **register for CRN# 20487 - GRD OOOB.** A \$160.00 graduation fee is added to your tuition invoice. The deadline for registering for summer graduation is **July 1, 2010.** Contact your advisor NOW for a graduation audit to be sure you meet all degree requirements.

### New Students

Any student who has never taken a Wilkes graduate course must submit a Wilkes graduate application before registering for a class. Apply online at [www.wilkes.edu/applyonline](http://www.wilkes.edu/applyonline), or call for an application packet.

### Drops & Adds

To drop or add a course once registered, call 800-945-5378, ext. 4671, 2016, OR 4663 **You must call to drop BEFORE class begins, or you WILL BE charged a portion of tuition even if you did not attend or log in to class. You can also drop yourself from a course online if the semester has not started yet.**

### Fee Structure for Graduate Education Students/Courses

**Tuition:** 2009-10 tuition rate is \$370 per credit or \$1,110 per 3 credit course + use-fee (all courses 3 credits). All online courses will be charged an additional fee of \$50.

**Graduate Application Fee:** A one-time fee must be paid at the time of application for all NEW Wilkes graduate students. Online application = \$35; Paper application = \$45.

**Graduation Fee:** A \$160.00 fee is charged the semester you register for graduation. Students need to register for graduation GRD OOOB when taking the last course for MS degree.

### Tuition payment options

1) **Personal deferment (automatic with online registration) allows payment at end of the course, but no later than 30 days after your last class.** 2) Mail a check or authorize immediate credit card payment by filling in the required information on a paper registration form. 3) Pay tuition online via MyWilkes portal noted above AFTER June 15th & print your own receipt. Note: A **"finance hold"** preventing future course registration and/or issuing of grade reports, transcripts & graduation clearances is placed on any student account with past-due balance until full payment is received and processed.

### Class confirmations are NOT mailed to students

If a course is full or cancelled, you will be notified. If we do not contact you, your class is a go, so attend class on the dates/times listed on this course schedule.

**Wilkes Campus - No Facilities-Use Fee**

\*ON-CAMPUS PARKING: Parking for students will be available in the Student Union lot. No permit is necessary after 4:30.
