


The 57 photographs exhibited in the Sordoni Art Gallery were taken by Mark Cohen on a National Endowment for the Arts Grant during the summer of 1975. Most of the pictures were taken in London, a few in Salisbury and Brighton. All of the prints were made on Kodak Polycontrast Rapid F paper in 8"x10", 11"x14" and 16"x20" sheet sizes. The photographs in the catalogue were selected from the original prints shown at the Visual Studies Workshop in Rochester, New York, in 1976.
