



THIS YEAR is the 59th year that *Scholastic Magazines, Inc.*, with the cooperation of civic-minded sponsors, is conducting an art awards program for the high school students of America. With its aim of encouraging student achievement in creative art at an age when encouragement is important, the project has started many worthy students on their way toward advanced study and careers in the art field.

BOSCOV'S celebrates its sixth anniversary year of Scholastic Art Awards regional sponsorship in 1986. Central Pennsylvania's largest department store, Boscov's continues its long history of community involvement and concern for the youth of our region.

REGIONAL HONORS in the Eastern Pennsylvania Scholastic Art Awards include the Certificate of Merit, for honorable mention, and the gold achievement key, for work deserving extra commendation. All the pieces shown in the Regional Exhibition have been awarded the Certificate of Merit. Gold key and finalist selections were made by the regional jury.

NATIONAL HONORS include special prizes and gold medals, mounted on plaques and engraved and given in all art classifications. In addition, seniors who have submitted portfolios of their best work are eligible to win scholarships to art schools, colleges, and universities throughout the country. Regional juries choose individual pieces and senior portfolios to go on to the national competition.

SPECIAL AWARDS, given for outstanding achievement in the Eastern Pennsylvania Regional Exhibition, are listed below.

HALLMARK HONOR PRIZE — a \$100 purchase prize for the best drawing or painting, sponsored by Hallmark Cards, Incorporated. Selected by the national judges from five pieces nominated by the regional jury.

KODAK MEDALLION OF EXCELLENCE — a gold medallion for the best photograph, sponsored by Eastman Kodak Company. Selected by the national judges from five photographs nominated by the regional jury.

WYOMING VALLEY ART LEAGUE AWARDS — three cash awards, sponsored by the Wyoming Valley Art League, and presented for achievement in drawing and painting. Awards selected by the regional judges.

WILKES COLLEGE ART DEPARTMENT AWARDS — several cash awards, sponsored by the art department, given for meritorious achievement in any of the thirteen classifications. Awards selected by the Wilkes Art Faculty.

LLEWELLYN & McKANE AWARD — an award of \$25 for achievement in the graphic design classification, sponsored by Llewellyn & McKane Inc., manufacturers of fine printing. Award selected by the regional judges.

KEN POLLOCK AWARD — an engraved sterling silver medallion award for outstanding ability demonstrated in the jewelry classification. Sponsored by Frank Clark, Incorporated. Award selected by regional judges.

DOROTHY BRACE BARBER MEMORIAL WATERCOLOR AWARDS — four \$25 gift certificates, sponsored by Sue Hand's Imagery and presented for achievement in watercolors. Awards selected by the regional judges.

NORTHEASTERN PENNSYLVANIA ART WORKSHOP SCHOLARSHIP — given to two high school students for outstanding achievement in drawing and painting. Awards selected by regional judges.

REGIONAL SPONSORS AWARD — \$50 worth of art or photography supplies from Boscov's. Presented to the student who submits the most outstanding portfolio. Award selected by regional judges.

SWEET BASIL TWO AWARD — a \$25 award for a greeting card design, sponsored by Sweet Basil Two. Award selected by regional judges.

PLYMOUTH GRAPHICS AWARD — a \$25 award for a pen and ink drawing given by Plymouth Graphics. Award selected by regional judges.
