

FAQ – ANDROID – HOW DO I CONNECT TO WILKES WIRELESS?

Purpose

- This guide details the steps for connecting to the Wilkes University wireless networks using an Android device

Requirements

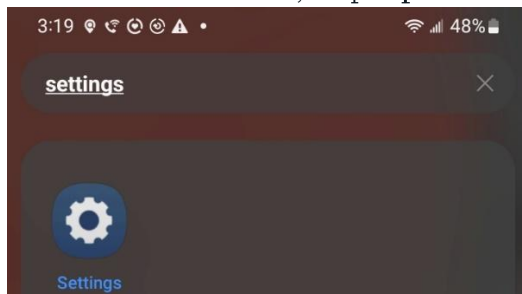
- Active Wilkes Account
- Android Device

Notes

- If your device is currently connected to a different Wilkes wireless network, you may first need to forget the connection
- When you change your Wilkes account password, you will need to update your device with your new password to avoid locking out your account

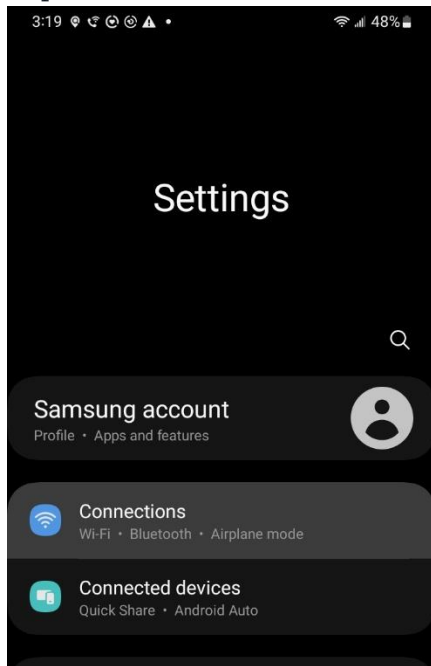
Process

1. From the **Home Screen**, swipe **up** and search for and open **Settings**



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2. Tap the **Connections** tab in the settings menu

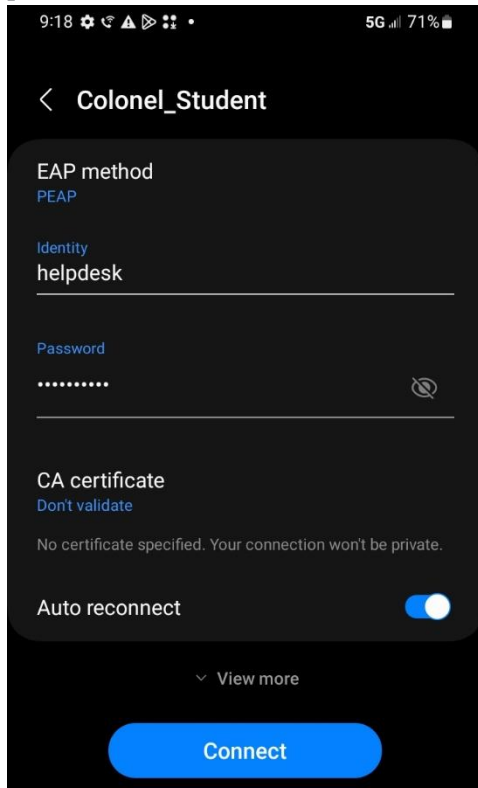


3. Select the appropriate network
 - a. **Colonel_Fac-Staff**: this is the network for faculty and staff
 - b. **Colonel_Student**: this is the network for students



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4. In the **Identify** field, enter your Wilkes username and in the **Password** field, enter your Wilkes password. In the **CA certificate** field, select **Don't validate** and then tap **Connect**



5. You should now be connected to the wireless network
