This guide applies to open access and other lab computers on campus that are running Windows 7.

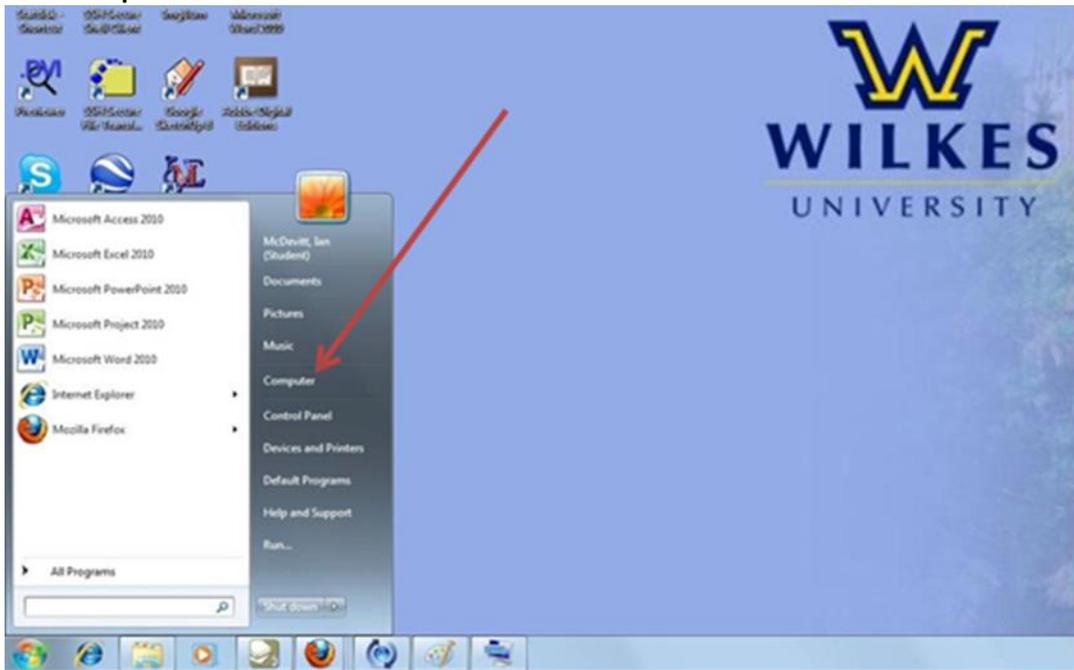
Process

1. Click the Windows **Start** button.

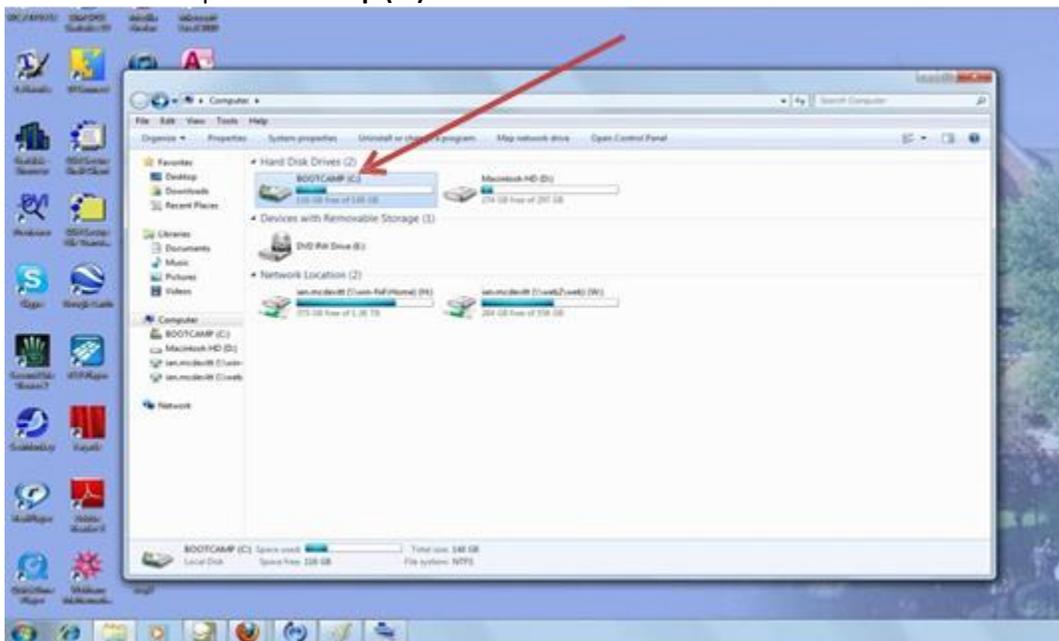


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2. Click **Computer**.

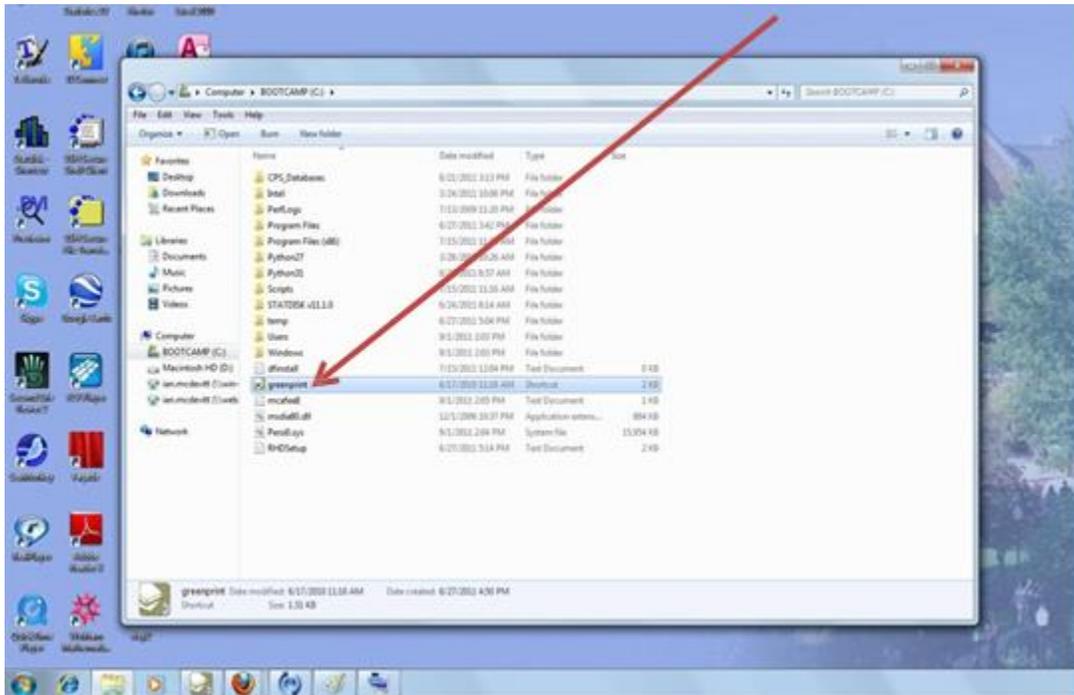


3. Double click to open **Bootcamp (C:)**.
