



Students admitted to the Honors Program must take an Honors section of a cohort-based, three-credit class in their first undergraduate year ('First Year Foundations') that counts toward University core requirements.

They also must take 18 Honors credits - six of which must be at the 300 level or above - as well as a one-credit Honors senior seminar.

All of these requirements are in addition to individual major and University graduation requirements.
